Golden Years in High School District 211

You are eligible for membership in the *Golden Years Club* if you are:

- A resident of Township High School District 211 (*Palatine and Schaumburg Townships*)
- Age 62 or older

To secure a *Golden Years Club* card, you must apply in person at the Continuing Education office:

Membership guidelines:

- *Golden Years Club* members must present their *Gold Card* at High School District 211 events in order to receive the applicable benefit
- *Gold Cards* are not transferable
- *Gold Cards* are **not** honored at State Athletic Tournament games
- Seats may be reserved at special events, theater presentations, or classes if prior arrangements are made (*to reserve seats, call the school that is hosting the event*)

Benefits of membership:

As a *Golden Years* member, you are eligible for:

- Free or reduced rates in the Continuing Education Program which offers over 200 recreational, educational, and self-enrichment courses on evenings and weekends
- Free or reduced rates at school plays, musicals, concerts, and athletic events (*State Tournament games excluded*)
