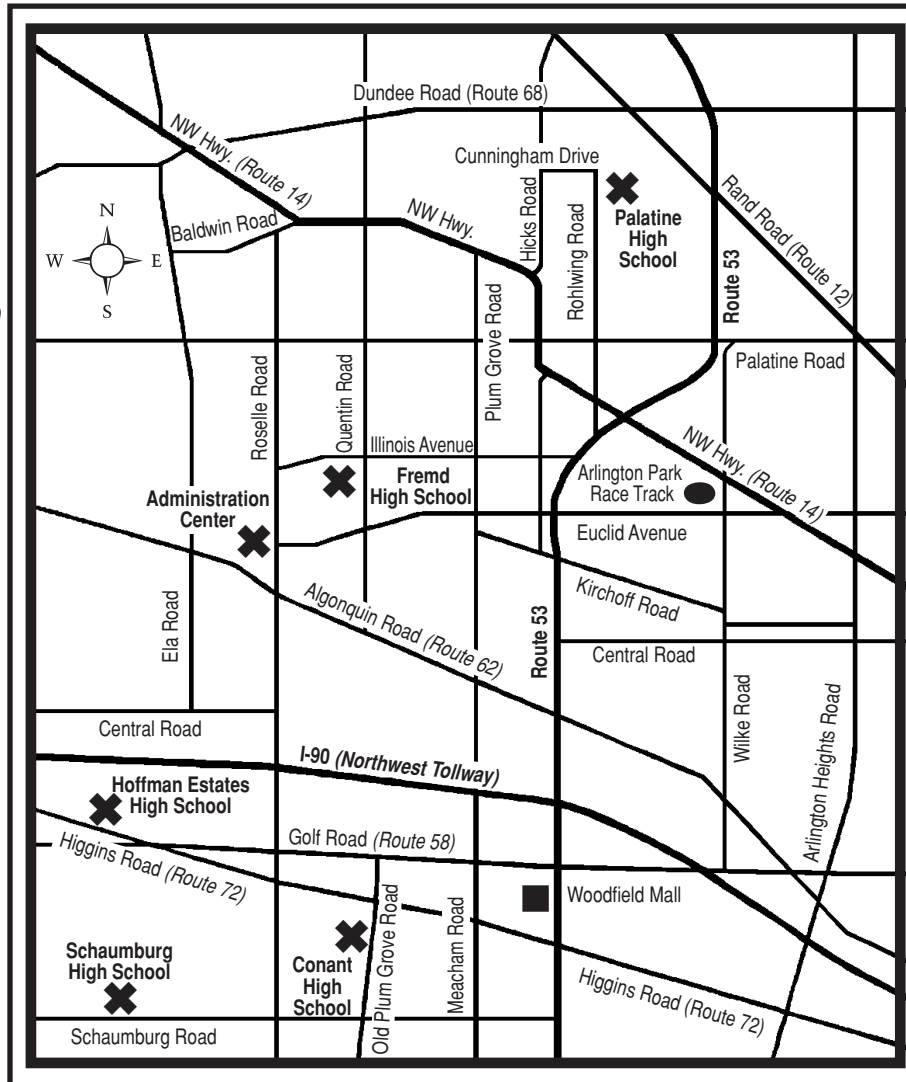

Who should take the Placement Test?

All students entering 9th grade at a District 211 school during the fall of 2009 *must take* a placement test. Students will be placed in high school classes using placement test results and recommendations from junior high school teachers.

When and where does the Placement Test take place?

The placement test will be given at:

William Fremd High School
Saturday, December 6, 2008
8:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.

High School District 211 will provide bus transportation to and from Fremd High School. Bus information will be mailed to each family.

If you plan to provide your own transportation to Fremd High School, your child ***must arrive no later than 7:45 a.m. at the Guidance entrance (#2).*** Testing begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. If you choose to drive your child home, ***please plan to pick up your child by 11:15 a.m.***

What should my child bring to the Placement Test?

Please bring the following to the placement test:

- two No. 2 pencils
- a calculator for the mathematics portion of the test (*allowed, though not required*)

Our high school rules prohibit food and electronic devices (including cell phones, MP3 players, and cameras) at the testing site. No money is required to take this test.

What Placement Test will my child be taking?

Your child will be taking the EXPLORE Test, part of the ACT Test series. The test includes the following sub-areas:

- Interest Inventory
- English
- Mathematics
- Reading
- Science

Test results allow us to make initial assessments of your child's skills and abilities. Information gathered from junior high school teacher recommendations and conferences are essential to High School District 211's placement process. This information may be used as criteria for placement in special programs, such as accelerated courses or general-level programs. Recommendations for summer school programs also may be made as a result of the test scores.

What if my child misses or cannot make the December 6 test date?

Please call Fremd High School's Student Services Department for additional information at (847) 755-2630. Only students who test on December 6 will receive an official score report from ACT Corporation.

What do I do if I have questions concerning the Placement Test?

When will I get the results of the Placement Test?

Placement Test results will be **mailed** to you *January 5, 2009*. Information about elective courses also will be sent at that time.

How do I enroll my child for high school?

An enrollment packet will be mailed to your home in November. *It must be completed and returned to Fremd High School by **December 5, 2008** in order to complete the enrollment process.* The office is open from 7:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

- Master Enrollment Form (*signed*)
- Proof of Residency (*gas or electric bill*)
- **Original** Birth Certificate

Selected junior high schools will arrange for enrollment documents to be collected by Fremd staff at the junior high. Specific dates will be announced by your child's school.

Students may also bring enrollment documents to Fremd on December 6. The documents will be processed while the students take the Explore test.
